New Audio Setup option (for page 11)

Downmix

Default setting: Pure Stereo

If you are going to apply Dolby Pro Logic decoding to the audio signal, set to **LtRt**. If you are not going to apply Dolby Pro Logic decoding to the audio signal, set to **Pure Stereo**.
