

LINN PRETEK/POWERTEK COMBINATION

The Pretek preamplifier and Powertek power amplifier are derived from the Linn Intek integrated amplifier released in 1988.

Using the same high quality components and construction methods Pretek and powertek offer improved performance by using independent power transformers.

The Powertek is capable of driving virtually any loudspeaker, including 4 ohm models. As it has identical gain to the power amplifier used in the Intek, Powertek can be used in multi-amplifier or active loudspeaker systems, and is ideal for use in distributed sound systems.

The Powertek provides over current and over temperature protection, an efficient heatsink, and is stable into any load.

This Linn power amplifier offers an easy upgrade route for existing Intek owners, as it can be connected to an Intek with no modification. For Linn Kaber owners the Powertek offers the possibility of building up through multi-amplification to an active system; an easy upgrade path to a great hi-fi.

The standard width and sleek appearance of Pretek and Powertek make it easy to match them with other components in an existing system.
